

Swach Bharath (cleaned Bcc college campus and nearby areas)

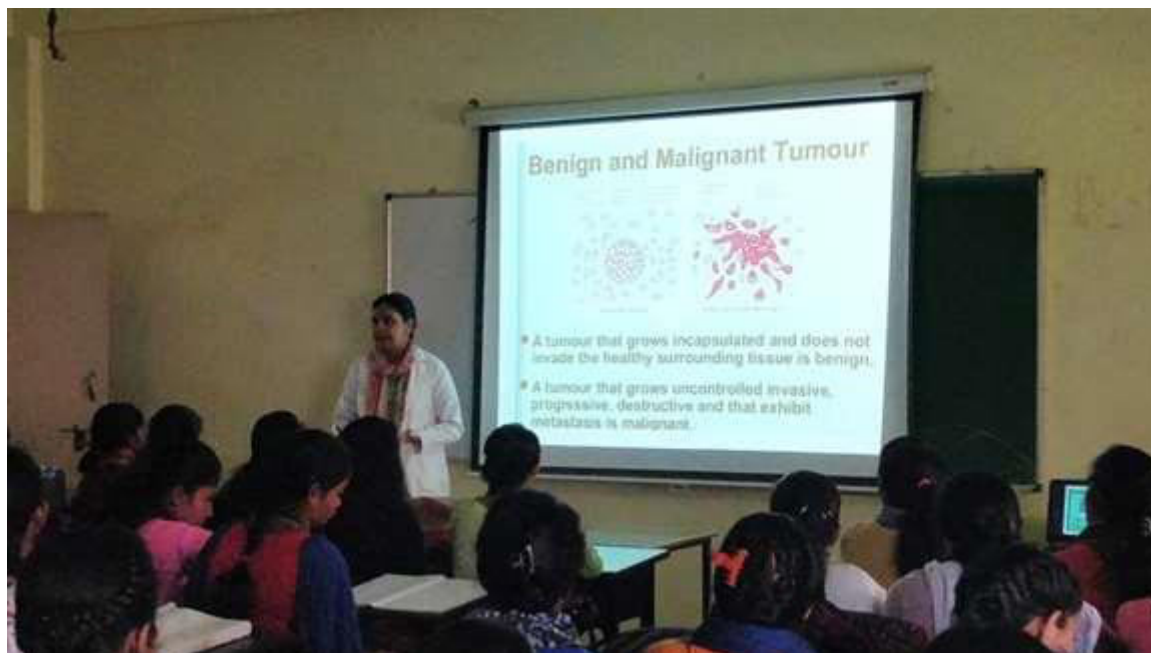

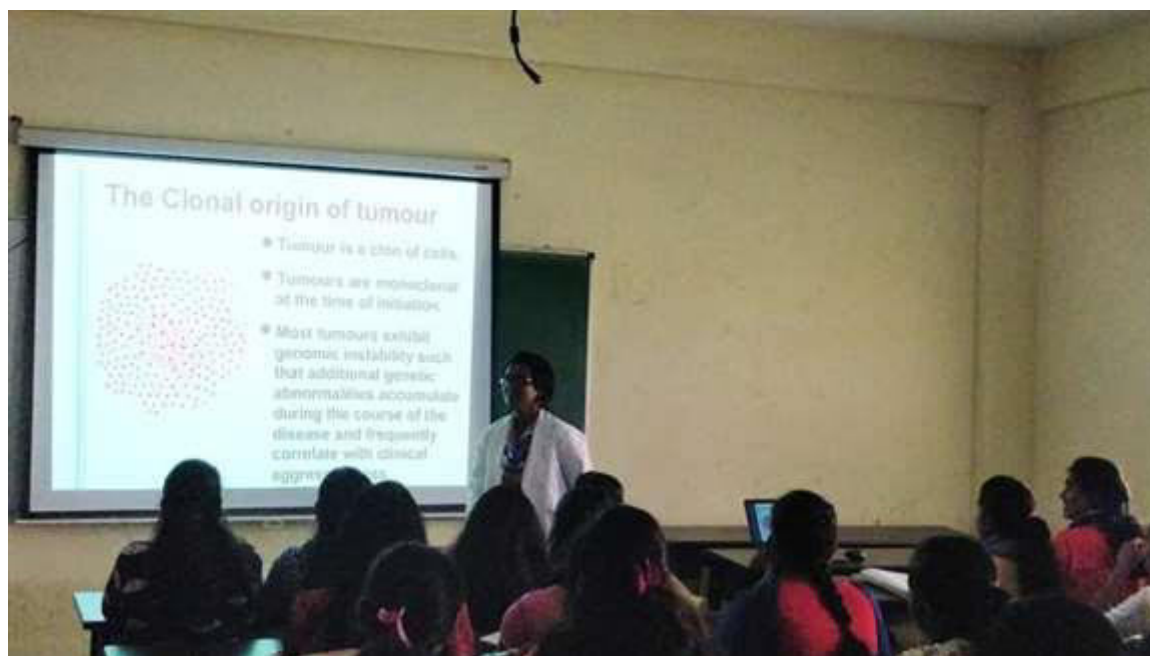

Thus it return out to be highly instructive, useful, interesting, innovative initiative very much beneficial to all the participants.

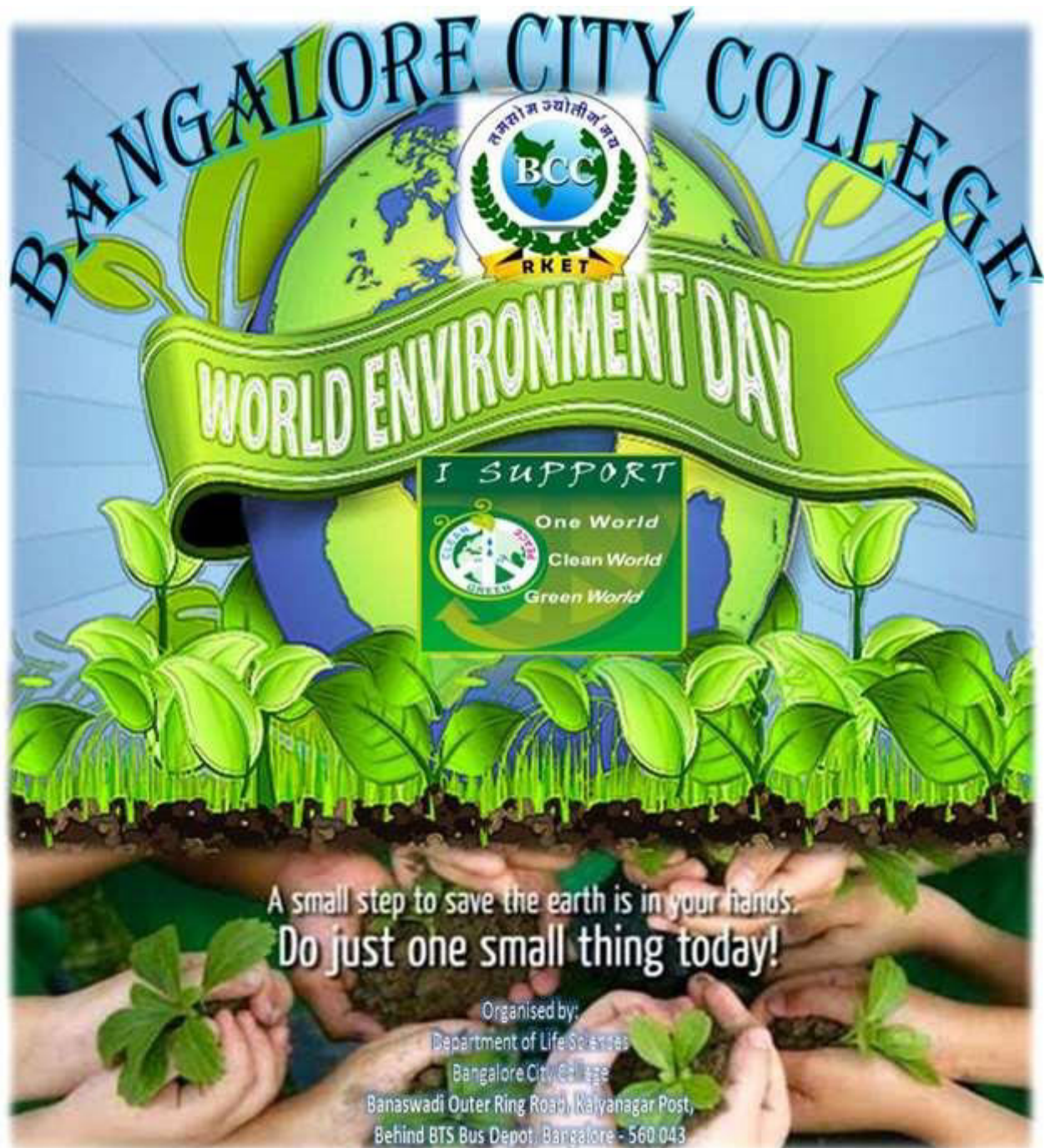
Myclinicare (Early Detection of Breast and Health Check-up)
