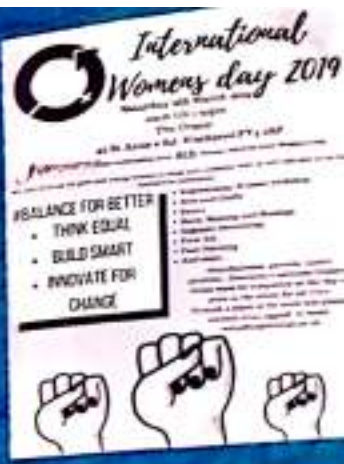

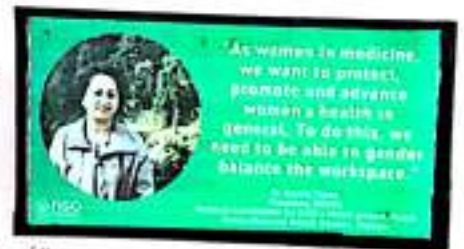

J&K law to stop 'sextortion' of women

First time in India legislation to prevent perpetrators from blackmailing women over sexual harassment cases

NEW DELHI The Jammu & Kashmir government has passed a law to prevent perpetrators from blackmailing women over sexual harassment cases. The law, which is the first of its kind in India, will allow women to file a complaint with the police if they are being threatened or harassed by a man who has been convicted of sexual harassment. The law also provides for the arrest of the perpetrator and the imposition of a fine of up to Rs 10,000.



The law is a significant step towards protecting women from sexual harassment and ensuring that they are able to report such incidents without fear of retaliation. It also provides a clear framework for the police to handle such cases and ensures that the perpetrators are held accountable for their actions.
